2008 – One of our projects was collecting books. The boys donated 2nd hand books and we bought new books for our Afri- Twin school, Rosmead Junior School. They do not have an existing library, so this was our input to help them start one.

2009 - Term 1:

The boys collected sandwiches for the Salvation Army. These were distributed to the homeless and shelters nearby.

Term 2:

We raised money for the Red Cross Children's hospital. Specifically the money raised from our civvies day went to their Natural Disasters Management Fund.

Term 3:

We chose to support animals in need, by collecting for the SPCA. We managed to collect loose change in tins, 1 tin per grade. The boys also each paid money for a civvies day and received a ribbon to show their support for animal awareness day. As well as money raised by the boys also collected old blankets, beds and toys for their kennels. We were once again very proud to hand over a generous donation.

Term 4:

We decided to support a children's convalescent home called Sarah Fox. This home cares for toddlers to early teens recovering from the Red Cross. We collected 2nd hand toys as well as bought new toys and some clothes for each child there, to open as a Christmas present. The boys wrapped all the presents and some accompanied us to the home to deliver the presents and spend time with the children. The boys were touched after seeing children less fortunate than themselves, and they were pleased to see the children who would be opening their presents.

2010 - Term 1

The boys collected sandwiches for the Salvation Army. We delivered 5 big boxes full of lunch packs, healthy sandwiches, juices, fruit and sweets. These lunches went to a pre-school in the Cape Flats which feeds over 100 toddlers on their own.

We were extremely proud of the compassion and generosity shown by our Wynberg Boys.

Term 2:

Winter warmers: The boys have decided to start collecting warm blanket, jackets and jerseys for the start of winter. We will still be looking into where would be best to donate these to. Thus far our club members have shown enormous involvement in this cause. We will be extending the collection to the rest of the school in due course.
